Graduated with honours at 17 years old at Conservatoire G. Verdi in Milan, obtaining the *Pina Carmirelli Prize* as best violinist in the academic year, she currently studies with Sergej Krylov, graduating *cum laude* in *Master of Arts in Music Performance* (2018) and *cum laude* in *Master of Arts in Specialized Music Performance* for soloists (2020). After her debut with Bacau Philharmonic Orchestra in Romania with Tchaikovsky violin concerto, she started to pursue an intense professional career, in recitals, chamber music and soloist with orchestra performances, interested in a wide repertoire till XX century and contemporary music. She has been invited to play for prestigious Artistic Associations and Foundations and important Theatres, in Italy - among which *Unione Musicale* in Turin, MITO, *Serate Musicali* in Milan, *Amici della Musica di Padova* at Sala dei Giganti in Palazzo Liviano, *MantovaMusica* at Teatro Bibiena, *Bologna Festival* at Rocca Isolani Minerbio, *I Concerti della Normale di Pisa* at Palazzo della Carovana, *Accademia dei Cameristi di Bari* - debuting at Ponchielli Theatre in Cremona, Sala Verdi, Auditorium Fondazione Cariplo, Arcimboldi Theatre, Filodrammatici Theatre, Gerolamo Theatre and Palazzina Liberty in Milan, Palazzo Barolo in Turin, Teatro Grande in Brescia, Philharmonic Theatre in Verona, Palazzo Pisani in Venice, Palazzo Chigi Saracini in Siena, Cappella Palatina in Caserta's Reggia and abroad in Germany, Austria - *Musikverein* in Vienna - in Switzerland, France, Belgium, Spain, Great Britain, Norway, Greece, Romania and USA. Among the recent prestigious collaborations, she played with the pianist Itamar Golan, the double bassist and conductor Enrico Fagone playing the Bottesini *Gran Duo Concertante* with *Savaria Symphony Orchestra* and she debuted with Orchestra della Svizzera Italiana at LAC Lugano, performing Bernd Alois Zimmermann violin concerto conducted by Arturo Tamayo and Alfred Schnittke *Sonata N. 1* conducted by Kevin Griffiths. She debuted in Florence with *La Filharmonie Orchestra* playing Samuel Barber violin concerto conducted by Nima Keshavarzi. She has collaborated with renowned musicians as Rocco Filippini, Franco Petracchi and Roberto Paruzzo, with Robert Kowalsky, Andrea Rebaudengo, Sandro Laffranchini and soloists of Teatro La Scala Philharmonic Orchestra, with Emanuele Torquati and Alfredo Zamarra for *Accademia dei Cameristi di Bari* and for the contemporary repertoire, with *Sentieri Selvaggi*, ensemble conducted by Carlo Boccadoro and *900Presente*, Festival in Lugano, Switzerland. Cremonesi*, *International Valtidone Competition*, *Concorso Città di Cremona*, *Solista e Orchestra Senza spine* in Bologna with Tchaikovsky violin concerto. She attended solo and chamber music masterclasses with Salvatore Accardo at W. Stauffer Academy in Cremona and Chigiana Academy.
